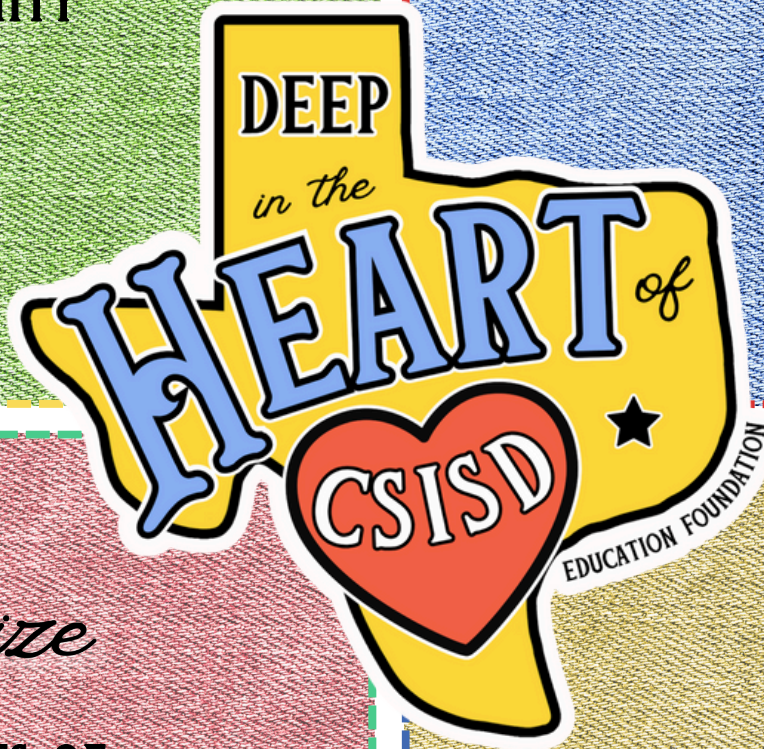

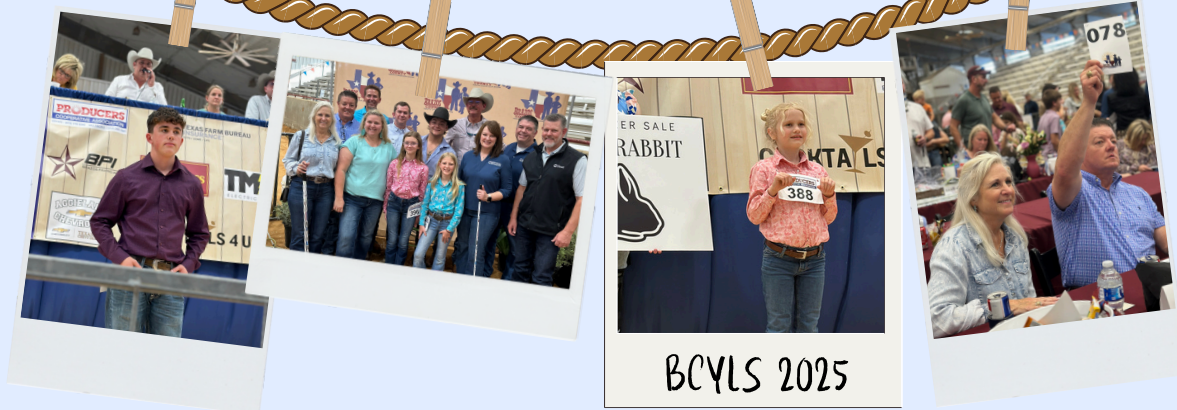




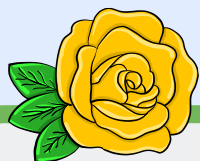


# Ag Initiative AROUND THE BARN

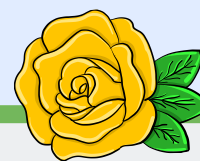

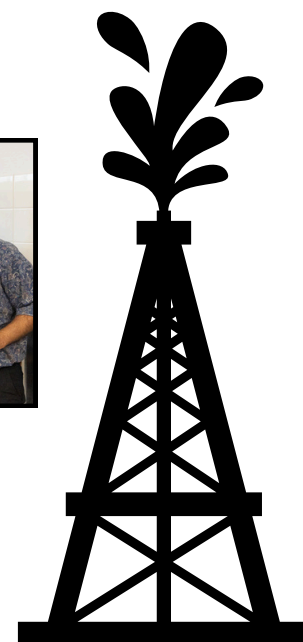
